

PETROL TANKS

As with the UK, Australian-assembled MGBs had two distinct fuel tanks over their 10 year lifespan. The initial style, which was found on the earlier YGHN3 vehicles, was a 10 gallon (45 litres) steel tank, attached by two straps. In April, 1965 this tank was changed. The new tank, had an increased capacity; 12.7 gallons (58 litres) and was attached directly to the underneath of the boot floor by means of bolts. As the photos show, they were different in appearance.
