Below is an extract from an email I received today re Securon Seat Belts in my 1968 MGB Mk 2.

Dear Mr,

Thank you for your enquiry with regard to the approval of Securon seat belts for fitment to Australian vehicles.

Further to our telephone conversation, I understand that you propose to install Securon 514/30 model seat belts in a 1968 MGB.

As the vehicle was manufactured prior to the compulsory fitment of seat belts to vehicles for sale in Australia, and does not incorporate any advanced occupant protection systems, such as airbags, it is considered that the fitment of aftermarket seat belts, manufactured to comply with Australian Design Rule (ADR) 04/05, is acceptable.

The proposed Securon seat belts are marked as meeting AS/NZS 2596 and European Regulation R16. Both of these standards are referenced in ADR 04/05 as being equivalent to the ADR.

Consequently, provided that the proposed seat belts are installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, they meet all current requirements for fitment to a 1968 model vehicle.
